## About Our College

“Ipsa scientia potestas est” ~ Francis Bacon

Government General Degree College at Kaliganj started its academic voyage in 2015 as a part of the august aim of the Government of West Bengal to allow access to higher education in hitherto marginalized parts of the state. Our college is one of the twenty new government general degree colleges of the state which started to function from the 2015-2016 academic session. The college is now on the third year of its journey.

Affiliated to the University of Kalyani, the college offers Honours Courses in six subjects, four in Humanities (Bengali, English, Sanskrit and History) and two in Science (Botany and Physiology). It is also offering General Courses in both Humanities (Bengali, English, Sanskrit and History) and Science (Botany, Physiology, Zoology and Chemistry). At present there are 477 registered students in the college. The college has 15 permanent teachers, 2 permanent non-teaching staff and also 9 contractual non-teaching staff.

## About Science Departments

Since its inception, the government has given its emphasis on the science departments. There are four science departments, as mentioned earlier. The thrust is obviously on the biological science departments, with Botany and Physiology offering both Honours and General courses. Zoology is till now offered only as General course but we have plans to open Honours course in Zoology from the next academic session subject to the permission of the competent authorities. The continuous flow of government grants have significantly embellished the laboratories of all the science departments and we sincerely believe that in two years time, our laboratories can be raised to the level of excellence.

We have completed the first two years, if we dare to say so, with moderate degree of success. The students have fared considerably well in the university examinations and have participated with zeal and enthusiasm in all academic and extra-curricular activities. However, there is no luxury of being complacent as we have indeed “miles to go before [we] sleep”. The only way for us is to march forward and we sincerely hope that this one-day Science Seminar will be an integral part of our forward movement.

## About the Seminar

Biology is the natural science that involves the study of life and living organisms, including their physical and chemical structure, function, development and evolution. Despite the broad scope and the complexity of the science, there are certain unifying concepts that consolidate it into a single, coherent field. Despite the profound advances made over recent decades in our understanding of life's fundamental processes, some basic problems have remained unresolved.

The proposed One-day Seminar aims to highlight and explore some of the major perspectives in order to look back into the richness and diversity as well as look forward to its evolving multidimensional prospects and connotations. Since the subject-area is hugely copious the one-day seminar shall have to restrict itself to some selected themes. Scanned Copy of Registration Form to be sent along with the abstract. The name of the presenting author should be subscripted by an asterisk.\*\*\* Abstract will be reviewed by a technical committee and acceptance of the abstract will be communicated to the authors for Poster Presentation only. The Posters should be 90cm×120cm in size in Portrait Mode.

\*\*\* Co-authors other than the presenting author (or Accompanying Persons) will have to undergo the

registration process separately in the event of more than one author intend to attend the seminar.
